Contributions are also welcome if they lay at the intersection of two or more topics (crossin-cutting themes as governance, inequality, transparency...) or if they have a wider focus and include a case study falling within one of the four topics listed above.

The ideal contribution is not just an analysis of the problem, but a proposal for addressing it democratically in some original or unconventional way, yet feasible.

Those who want to send a contribution but will not attend, could signal their intention by the deadline and send the final contribution as a poster. Posters will be displayed in the locations of workshops and events.
